Trish has also worked for the California Hospital Association as an Education Program Manager. In that role, she led teams in developing and disseminating educational conferences and webinars to help health care providers and professionals remain compliant in the complex and rapidly evolving health care delivery environment. Trish's programs included the association's annual member legislative advocacy events in Sacramento and Washington, D.C., and the Disaster Planning Conference, a gathering of more than 800 hospital emergency preparedness coordinators and state and local officials.
